Outreach clinics: Ophthalmology, Foot Clinic, & Mental Health Nurse.

Care Providers: Physicians, Registered Nurses, Laboratory Technologist, Laboratory Assistant, Radiology Technologist, Registered Dietitian, and Receptionist.

We have a Heliport for the transport of critically ill or injured patients by Emergency Health Services – Life Flight.

Examples of Urgent Treatment Needs:

- mild abdominal pain
- simple fractures
- limb strains / muscle sprains
- mild headaches
- minor infections
- earaches
- lacerations
- mild asthma / respiratory issues
- skin & eye irritations

Examples of Outpatient Services:

- procedures booked by physicians
- procedures that cannot be performed in a doctor's office
- booked clinics
- blood transfusions
- intravenous therapy
- wound care

Triage and registration of patients is required before treatment can begin. A Nurse will determine the patient's level of seriousness. The most seriously ill are cared for first (Triage).

Registration is necessary to create a record of your visit and to correctly identify you.
